

MAY DAY CALL SCRIPT

- Hi, my name is _____ and I am calling from _____ to invite you to this year's May Day celebration and action.
- May Day is International Workers' Day. It's a time for the entire (99% / working class) to join together and demand the respect we deserve.
- There will be a march through Providence leaving from Armory Park (Dexter St. between Cranston and Westminster Streets) leaving at 3pm.
- The march will stop at a couple key sites in the city, including (*pick one or two most related to the person's interest*):
 - Providence School Department: *Defend Public Education! No more pink-slips for teachers! No more school closings!*
 - Verizon: *Stop Corporate Greed! Protect Worker's Rights!*
 - City Hall: *Who's Providence? OUR Providence! Demand Local Jobs and a Fair Economy!*
 - Bank of America: *Stop Foreclosures; Stop Evictions! Foreclose the Banks!*
 - Federal Building: *No human being is illegal! Stop Deportations! Immigration Reform Now!*
- After the march, around 5:30, people will head back to the park for a celebration. There will be food, music, and games for kids.
- Will you join with us on May 1st?
 - *If yes*: Great! We'll see you there.
 - *If it applies, ask if they'll need a ride*
 - *If no/maybe (because of work)*: People all around the world will be taking May Day off of work to celebrate this worker's holiday. I know that times are tough right now, but consider calling out of work that day or leaving early to participate. In years past, many businesses have closed on May Day because so many workers have said they won't work. Remember, May Day is OUR day.
